

Vital Facts


- Global logistics industry 13.8 % global GDP (2006) EUR 5.4 trillion (estimate)

- Contributing \$90 billion to the Australian economy annually
- Second largest employer (3.5 million workers in Australia, 500,000 in Victoria)
- Vital to Australia's competitiveness, productivity and economic future
- The west and northern crescent of Melbourne constitute Australia's fastest growing commercial and industrial/freight area




Bachelor of Business (Supply Chain and Logistics Management)
