Learn the basics in woodwork, home maintenance and bricklaying. Victoria University is offering short courses to do it yourself, save money and gain skills that will hold you in good stead for future DIY projects.

YOU CAN CHOOSE ONE OF THREE SHORT COURSES CURRENTLY RUNNING

BASIC WOODWORK - Be taught by a female teacher

Learn how to make a planter box or bedside cabinet. Get acquainted with woodworking tools such as chisels, a marking gauge, planes, dovetail and tenon saws. This will help you to create many basic wooden objects for around the home or garden.

HOME MAINTENANCE

This course will teach you to create a basic wall frame and hang a door. Learn to create a door opening, fit door jams, hinges and locks. Other home maintenance skills you will learn are sharpening chisels and using hand planes.

BRICKLAYING

This course covers basic bricklaying and paving. Learn how to lay pavers, lay sand beds and save on expensive labour costs. You will also learn the skills needed to build your own BBQ or garden bed/retaining wall.

All course are taught by highly trained professionals who work in the industry and we have both male and female teachers.
